AAYSA is your Local Soccer Association committed to good sportsmanship and quality of play for our players while ensuring a safe a fun environment for all soccer participants.

AAYSA will enforce a code of conduct for all players, coaches, team managers, club administrators, parents, spectators, and referees that must be adhered to.

AAYSA has a policy of ZERO TOLERANCE for behaviors, comments, and actions that endanger or threaten the environment of good sportsmanship and safe play for all soccer participants. This includes but is not limited to the following:

1. The use of foul language, abusive or derogatory comments towards referees, coaches, team officials, players, or parents by any individual while at the soccer fields or in the parking premises.
2. Any issue involving physical altercations, threatening, and assault or battery of any players, referees, coaches, team officials, parents, or club administrators.
3. The use of tobacco, vapes, alcoholic beverages or drugs on any fields is prohibited (this includes practice & playing fields).

Such offenses can lead to the removal from any AAYSA approved premises, and a ban (temporarily or permanently) from all AAYSA/STYSA sanctioned activities (which include practices, games, and tournaments).
